## Understanding what it really takes to build a sustainable music career today

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# The 3-step Framework every Musicpreneur needs

1. **LEARN** — *Get Clear on your Music*
2. **SHOWCASE** — *Let the World Hear You*
3. **CONNECT** — *Build your Network*



# 1. LEARN: Get Clear on YOUR MUSIC

Before you can showcase or connect, clarity on your music is essential.

## Your Sound

- Describe your music in one sentence.
  - Identify your target audience.
  - Define what makes you unique in your genre.
- ***If this takes you longer than a minute, clarity is needed. This foundation guides every decision.***

## Your Story

- Where did you grow up musically?
  - What's your 'why'? (Why music? Why now?)
  - One defining reason that shaped your sound.
- ***Your story is your strongest connection with your audience.***

## Your Business Basics

- Do you have email, website, or social profile?
  - Are you registered for royalties?
  - Have you claimed your music on platforms?
- ***These are essentials. Without them, visibility and earning potential are limited.***

## 2. SHOWCASE: Let the World Hear You

Once you know who you are, present your music strategically.

### Your Portfolio

- 3–5 of your best songs/recordings.
  - Do they reflect your best sound and production quality?
  - Can people access them easily?
- ***Your portfolio is your first impression; quality and accessibility matter.***

### Your Online Presence

- Platform where people can find your music.
  - Branding consistent across platforms.
- ***Search your name online. Outdated or inconsistent presence can limit opportunities.***

### Your Content Strategy

- Monthly plan for posts/shares.
  - Media prepared (photos, videos, behind-the-scenes).
- ***Consistency beats perfection. One regular post is better than scattered activity.***

### Your Track Record

- Performed live?
  - Evidence of growth?
  - Demonstrate development?
- ***Proof convinces promoters, venues, and collaborators of your commitment.***



### 3. CONNECT: Build Your Network

Talent alone is rarely enough. Relationships create opportunities and sustain careers.

#### Your Fanbase

- Know your top listeners?
  - Can you reach them directly?
  - Are they engaged?
- ***Followers ≠ fans. True fans engage, share, and show up.***

#### Your Collaborators

- Know 5 musicians you respect?
  - Publicly supported their work?
  - Open to collaboration?
- ***Music thrives on relationships. Isolation limits growth; connection creates opportunity.***

#### Your Mentors

- Someone ahead of you in music?
  - Asked them for guidance?
  - Learning from their path?
- ***Learning from those slightly ahead accelerates progress and avoids unnecessary mistakes.***

#### Your Support System

- 2–3 people who believe in your music?
  - Honest feedback?
  - Hold you accountable?
- ***Motivation fluctuates. A support system sustains long-term progress.***
